Know Your True Self

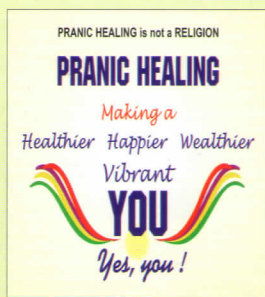

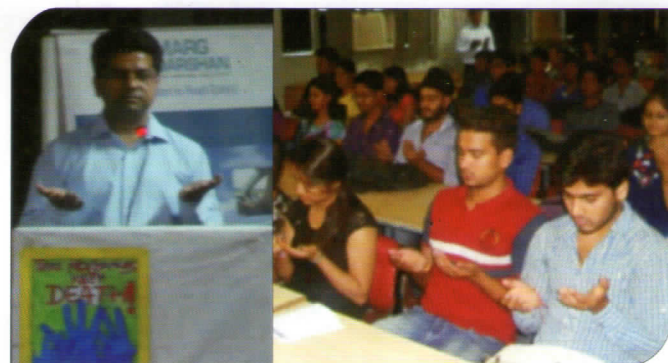
Workshop on Pranic Healing
